MEAN DAILY FLOW FORECAST FOR THE SUSQUEHANNA RIVER AT HARRISBURG FOR THE 24 HOUR PERIOD BEGINNING AT 7 AM:

TODAY: 27,300 TOMORROW: 30,000 NEXT DAY: 31,000

THESE FORECASTS ASSUME A CONTINUATION OF PRESENT RESERVOIR RELEASES AND BASIN AVERAGED RAINFALL AMOUNTS OF ONE TENTH TO ONE THIRD INCH THROUGH TUESDAY MORNING.

RAINFALL DURING THE PAST 24 HOURS ENDING THIS MORNING RANGED FROM LESS THAN ONE TENTH INCH TO ONE THIRD INCH.

MINOR RISES OF ONE TO TWO FEET ARE EXPECTED OVER THE NEXT FEW DAYS.
