REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE STATE COLLEGE PA 1115 AM EDT THU MAR 19 2009

THIS MORNING...SCATTERED RAIN SHOWERS WERE SEEN ACROSS MUCH OF THE COMMONWEALTH WITH SOME AREAS IN NORTHEAST PENNSYLVANIA SEEING SOME SNOW MIX WITH THE RAIN. THIS PRECIPITATION IS AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT WHICH WILL PASS THROUGH THE REGION THIS AFTERNOON BRINGING WITH IT UNSEASONABLY COLD TEMPERATURES. THE PRECIPITATION WILL MOVE PAST THE REGION BY LATER THIS AFTERNOON AND SKIES WILL BEGIN TO CLEAR. EXPECT SOME SUNSHINE LATE IN THE DAY OVER NORTHERN AND WESTERN PORTIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND MOSTLY CLOUDY SKIES OVER AREAS IN THE SOUTH AND EAST.

HIGH TEMPERATURES TODAY WILL REACH FROM THE UPPER 30S IN NORTH CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA TO THE LOW 50S ALONG THE SOUTHER TIER OF THE COMMONWEALTH. OVERNIGHT...EXPECT LOW TEMPERATURES TO DROP INTO THE MID TEENS OVER THE NORTH CENTRAL MOUNTAINS WHILE TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY WILL LINGER AROUND FREEZING. FRIDAY LOOKS TO BE A MOSTLY SUNNY DAY ACROSS THE STATE WITH THE ONLY EXCEPTION BEING IN NORTHWEST AREAS WHERE THE SLIGHT CHANCE OF A SNOW SHOWER EXISTS. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL RANGE FROM THE MID 30S IN THE NORTH TO THE MID 40S IN SOUTHERN HALF OF THE STATE.
