AFTER DENSE FOG THIS MORNING...HIGH PRESSURE WILL BRING MOSTLY SUNNY SKIES ACROSS THE STATE THIS AFTERNOON. TEMPERATURES THIS MORNING WERE CHILLY WITH MOST AREAS IN THE THIRTIES WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE NORTHWESTERN MOUNTAINS WHICH STARTED OUT IN THE UPPER TWENTIES.

ABOVE AVERAGE TEMPEATURES ARE EXPECTED FOR TODAY AS A STORM SYSTEM APPROACHES FROM THE WEST. TEMPERATURES OVER THE SOUTHERN TWO-THIRDS OF THE STATE, EXCLUDING THE LAUREL HIGHLANDS, WILL BE BETWEEN 60 AND 65 DEGREES WHILE AREAS IN THE NORTHERN THIRD OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE LAUREL HIGHLANDS WILL SEE TEMPERATURES IN THE UPPER 50s.

ENJOY THE PLEASANT WEATHER TODAY BECAUSE TONIGHT CLOUDS WILL BE ON THE INCREASE. A FEW SHOWERS ARE NOT OUT OF THE QUESTION BY DAYBREAK. LOWS TONIGHT WILL RANGE FROM THE UPPER 30S IN THE NORTHERN TIER TO THE LOW TO MID FORTIES IN SOUTHERN PARTS.

SHOWERS WILL BECOME MORE NUMEROUS TOMORROW AND TEMPERATURES WILL REMAIN MILD WITH HIGHS IN THE 50S STATEWIDE. THE UNSETTLED WEATHER WILL CONTINUE THROUGH SUNDAY AT WHICH TIME A COLD FRONT WILL PASS THROUGH BRINGING BACK SUNNY CONDITIONS TO BY EARLY NEXT WEEK.
