A LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM CURRENTLY CENTERED OVER NORTHERN OHIO WILL PASS THROUGH NORTHWESTERN PENNSYLVANIA BRINGING A WIDE VARIETY OF WEATHER TO THE STATE. SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS WILL ACCOMPANY THE COLD FRONT...SOME THUNDERSTORMS IN SOUTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA COULD BE STRONG WITH GUSTY WINDS. AREAS OF PATCHY FOG COULD PERSIST LATE INTO THE AFTERNOON TODAY OVER EASTERN AREAS OF THE STATE. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL RANGE FROM THE UPPER 40S IN THE ALLEGHENY MOUNTAINS TO THE LOW 60S IN AREAS AROUND PHILADELPHIA.

FOLLOWING THE PASSAGE OF THE COLD FRONT..NORTHWEST WINDS WILL BRING IN A COOLER AIR MASS AND THE CHANCE OF SOME LAKE EFFECT SNOW SHOWERS. A DUSTING OF SNOW ACCUMULATION IS POSSIBLE OVER NORTHWESTERN PENNSYLVANIA AND THE ALLEGHENY MOUNTAINS OVERNIGHT. LOW TEMPERATURES WILL RANGE FROM THE UPPER 20S OVER THE NORTHERN AND ALLEGHENY MOUNTAINS TO THE UPPER 30S IN SOUTH CENTRAL AND SOUTHEASTERN PARTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

TEMPERATURES WILL REMAIN COOL TOMORROW...BUT SKIES WILL BE CLEARING AS AN AREA OF HIGH PRESSURE MOVES INTO THE REGION. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL BE IN THE UPPER 30S OVER THE ALLEGHENY MOUNTAINS, THE MID FORTIES OVER CENTRAL AND WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA AND THE LOW 50S IN THE SOUTHERN TEIR. SKIES TOMORROW NIGHT WILL BE MOSTLY CLEAR WITH TEMPERATURES RANGING FROM THE LOW 20S IN NORTHERN PARTS OF THE STATE TO NEAR FREEZING OVER SOUTHERN REGIONS.
