A STRONG HIGH PRESSURE SYSTEM CENTERED OVER CANADA...NORTH OF THE GREAT LAKES IS ALLOWING FOR IT TO BE A GLORIOUSLY SUNNY DAY HERE IN PENNSYLVANIA. TEMPERATURES WILL BE COOL THOUGH WITH HIGH TEMPERATURES RANGING FROM THE LOW TO MID 40S OVER THE NORTHERN AND LAUREL MOUNTAINS...TO THE LOW TO MID 50S IN SOUTH CENTRAL AND SOUTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA. NORTHWESTERLY WINDS WILL PICK UP THIS AFTERNOON MAKING IT FEEL EVEN COLDER. WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 20 AND 30 MPH ARE LIKELY.

THE CLOUDLESS SKIES WILL CONTINUE OVERNIGHT WITH LOWS DIPPING BELOW FREEZING THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE STATE...WELL BELOW AVERAGE TEMPERATURES FOR THIS TIME OF THE YEAR. TEMPERATURES WILL RANGE FROM THE MID TEENS IN THE NORTHERN MOUNTAINS TO THE MID TO UPPER TWENTIES IN THE SOUTHEAST.

THE HIGH PRESSURE SYSTEM BRINGING THIS BEAUTIFUL WEATHER WILL PUSH OFF TO THE EAST AS UNSETTLED WEATHER MOVES IN FROM THE OHIO RIVER VALLEY. AS A RESULT...CLOUDS WILL BE ON THE INCREASE LATE IN THE DAY MONDAY. OTHERWISE...MONDAY LOOKS TO BE A NICE DAY AND SEASONABLE WITH HIGHS IN THE 50S STATEWIDE. UNDER VARIABLY CLOUDY SKIES MONDAY NIGHT...LOW TEMPERATURES WILL RANGE FROM THE LOW TWENTIES OVER THE POCONOS TO AROUND 40 NEAR PITTSBURGH.

RAIN WILL OVERSPREAD THE COMMONWEALTH TUESDAY ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPROACHING AREA OF LOW PRESSURE. SOUTHERN AREAS OF PENNSYLVANIA ARE THE MOST LIKELY TO SEE STEADY RAINFALL TUESDAY. HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL ONCE AGAIN BE IN THE 50S STATEWIDE.

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
